Worldwide Parcel Express

Invoice must clearly describe shipments contents in English, itemized by number of units,value, country of origin .Freight charge and currency to be stated INCOTERMS & reason for export. If shipping terms & charges aren't included, CZ Customs will add charges at an agreed price per kilo for calculating duty & VAT. Zero values for individual commodities not accepted. Shipments to international fairs should be addressed to consignees broker if temporary import is required. Note following WPX restrictions:

1. From private person to private person: 2 L of wine or 1 L of spirits only, otherwise duty must be paid.
2. If unprocessed, Phytosanitary Certificate required.
3. State value of medium (CD, tape, diskettes) seperately from value of software. eg 1 diskette USD1, software USD499.
4. All parts must be individually itemized.
5. Phytosanitary certificate required.
6. Must be registered and approved by National Czech Institute for Pharmacy. Documentation must describe constitution conent, e.g. vitamins, skin, nail, hair & health food supplments; diety supplement (must be approved by hygienist) & herbal supp. (phytosanitary Certificate required).
7. Must describe type and content.
8. Non-stamped tobacco products are not allowed to import unless in very small quantity as testing samples tobacco manufacturers.
